

John 13:18-27 New Revised Standard Version (NRSV)

18 I am not speaking of all of you; I know whom I have chosen. But it is to fulfill the scripture, ‘The one who ate my bread^[a] has lifted his heel against me.’ **19** I tell you this now, before it occurs, so that when it does occur, you may believe that I am he.^[b] **20** Very truly, I tell you, whoever receives one whom I send receives me; and whoever receives me receives him who sent me.”

Jesus Foretells His Betrayal

21 After saying this Jesus was troubled in spirit, and declared, “Very truly, I tell you, one of you will betray me.” **22** The disciples looked at one another, uncertain of whom he was speaking. **23** One of his disciples—the one whom Jesus loved—was reclining next to him; **24** Simon Peter therefore motioned to him to ask Jesus of whom he was speaking. **25** So while reclining next to Jesus, he asked him, “Lord, who is it?” **26** Jesus answered, “It is the one to whom I give this piece of bread when I have dipped it in the dish.”^[c] So when he had dipped the piece of bread, he gave it to Judas son of Simon Iscariot.^[d] **27** After he received the piece of bread,^[e] Satan entered into him. Jesus said to him, “Do quickly what you are going to do.”
